

EOC Resource Assistance Line 360-416-1892:

- Assist at-risk individuals who are on quarantine or isolation with getting/picking up supplies/resources if no other option is available
- General information regarding locations that have curbside pick-up or delivery for groceries, food, pharmacy or special store hours
- Animal concerns and needs for at-risk individuals who are on quarantine or isolation
- Calls regarding Stay at Home Order and non-essential businesses concerns
- Calls regarding donations of resources/supplies that EOC may be able to use for distribution

Public Health Line 360-416-1500:

- Health related question concerning COVID-19
- Questions and concerns regarding essential businesses not following health guidelines

Skagit 911 Dispatch 360-428-3211:

- 911 for emergency
- Non-emergency business concerns – if they receive them, they put in a call for service, per their policy
